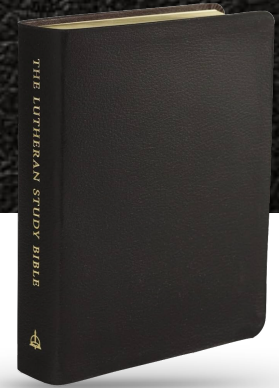


“THE CHRIST OF GOD.”
